

Location of the conference :

ENSIC (Ecole Nationale des Industries Chimiques)

– 1 Rue Grandville – 54000 Nancy.

There are several entry to access the campus.

The reception desk will be located in the building "Sellier 2".

The conference room is located in the same building, it is the amphitheater "Donzelot".

The CSME Conference will take place on ENSIC site (Ecole Nationale Supérieure des Industries Chimiques).

ENSIC is located in the city center of Nancy, at a walking distance from the railway and tram station.

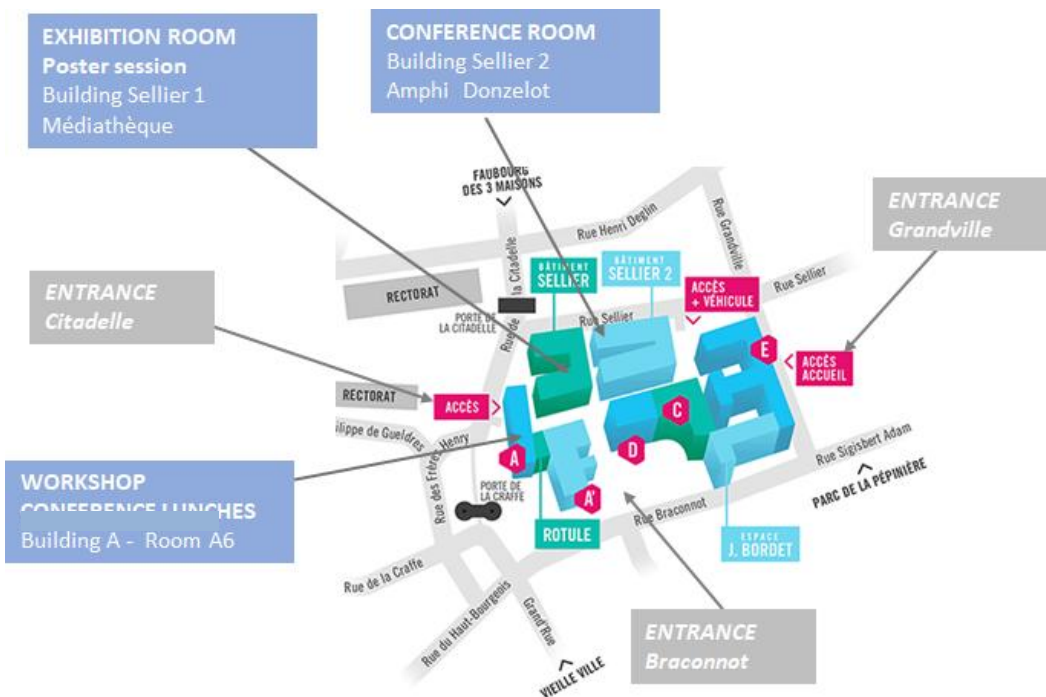

Discover Nancy

Nancy is located in North-East of France, in the heart of Europe, not far from Luxembourg, Germany and Belgium. Nancy is a city of Art and Science. With its 18th century UNESCO World Heritage Sites, its rich “Art Nouveau” heritage, outdoor terraces and relaxed way of life, you are guaranteed to fall in love with our city.

The “Place Stanislas” is on the UNESCO World Heritage list since 1983 and is one of the most beautiful squares of the world. Famous Place Stanislas will never fail to impress you. Its striking beauty and lively ambiance gives an Italian air to the city, year round. The Place d’Alliance, which resembles a mini Place des Vosges in Paris and The Place de la Carrière also received the honour.

The artistic mouvement “Art Nouveau” was created in Nancy, this style celebrated the beauty of Nature in a novel decorative art. Manufactures of luxury decorative arts such as Daum or Baccarat are still present around Nancy.

Travel Information

There are two main possibilities to reach Nancy:

- By train from many cities in France and in other European countries
- Flight to Paris, then train to Nancy

Other possibilities:

Coming By Train

Nancy station is in the center of the city.

Trains from Paris (Gare de l'Est station) take about 1h30 (high-speed TGV trains). Trains from Luxembourg or from Strasbourg take about 1h20.

You can also arrive to Lorraine TGV station, which is close to the regional airport (37 km from Nancy): a shuttle will take you into Nancy downtown in approximately 40 minutes. Note that the reservation of TGV is mandatory.

Coming By Plane

- From the Charles de Gaulle Airport

There are several high-speed TGV trains daily connecting Paris – Charles de Gaulle Airport to TGV Lorraine station in a little more than 1h.

You can also come via Paris Center (Gare de l'Est station). Take the line RER B – a train connecting the airport and Paris ([see the RER plan](#)).

The RER takes about 30-45 minutes. Getting from the terminal to the RER may take up to 30 minutes.

To get to the RER, follow the signs « Paris by Train, RER ». Get off the train at the Gare du Nord station and change for Metro line 4 (using the same ticket), direction Porte d'Orléans, and follow the directions.

It is only 1 stop from the Gare de l'Est. At the Gare de l'Est station, take a direct high-speed TGV train to Nancy (1h30).

-From Paris-Orly Airport

Take the ORLYVAL shuttle from the airport to the RER station «Antony». Change to RER B train, direction Paris center ([see the RER plan](#)). Get off the train at the Gare du Nord station and change for Metro line 4 (using the same ticket), direction Porte d'Orléans, and follow the directions. It is only 1 stop from the Gare de l'Est. At the Gare de l'Est station, take a direct high-speed TGV train to Nancy (1h30).

Coming By Car

- A31 (E21): Brussels, Luxembourg or Dijon – North Europe and Spain via Lyon and Marseille.
- A4 (E50/ E25): Paris, Berlin, Stuttgart, Vienna.
- Expressway N4 Paris Strasbourg.

Local transportation

TRAM

Taking the tram is the quickest and cheapest way going to /coming from the city center.
